

Stanmore Bowls Club- Competitions 2010

Members entering competitions should be available for both finals days if successful and for marking in earlier rounds. Competitors failing to play by due dates are liable to be scratched. See the Rules exhibited in the Club House. Finals days Sat 11th. and Sun.12th September 2010 (AM and PM) depending on the individuals being in more than 1 final.

The first named in the draw contacts his/her opponent to agree a date. First named asked another member to be the marker, except in pairs competition. As a trial this year- the looser should offer to mark in the next round. Men can mark for Ladies and the reverse.

Men's;

Championship; 4 bowls Winner is first to 21 shots. (Final is held on afternoon of Sunday 12th. September)

Handicap 4 bowls. Winner is first to 21 + the difference in the handicaps.

Novices Open to members who have not previously won a Club singles
Winner is first to 21 shots. 4 bowls to be played.

Ladies;

Championship. 4 bowls played to 21 shots. Final is played on afternoon of Sunday Sept 12th.

Handicap 4 bowls Winner is first to 21 shots plus her handicap

Two Woods. Winner is first to 21 ends. 2 bowls only

Junior Open to anyone who has not won a singles competition.
Winner is first to 21 shots. 4 bowls to be played.

Mixed

Two Woods. Winner is the first to 21 shots. 2 woods only.

Pairs; Entrants are placed in a draw. High handicap players are seeded to equalise the pairings. Pairs may be two men; two ladies or mixed; Play 4 bowls to 18 ends.
Final is held on afternoon of Saturday September 11th.-see above.

Jack Lines Played at anytime that the Green is open. Best of three 'sets' each played as winner first to 7 shots. Therefore could run for only 2 'sets' to 7 shots. 4 bowls played.

League Monday league 2.00 start –play till 4.30pm.or 14 ends. 3 play drawn from teams of 6, to a schedule so all teams play each other three times over the season. Full rules are on Notice Boards. *This league will only take place if there are entries sufficient to form the teams.* Organiser: Mr David Lush. We need at least 36 entries- please support it. £5 entry fee goes to winning and runner up team prize fund, presented at the Annual Dinner. No additional charge on the days you play – except Tea.

Competitions games are booked in the Diary for the Green, in the Club House.
